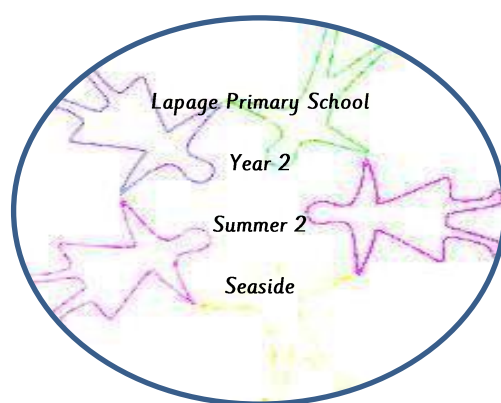

## Maths



*This half term we will:*

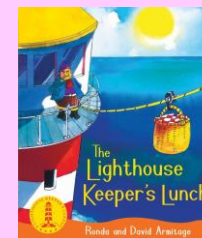
- *Describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three quarter turns.*
- *Comparing and sequencing intervals of time*
- *Tell and write the time to 5 minutes including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these time.*

*Support your child at home by practising counting back in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.*

*Completing Maths homework with your child.*

*Talk about what time of the day it is and what they usually do at that time.*

## English



*This half term we will be:*

- *Writing narratives about personal experiences and those of others linked to our core story of The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch*
- *Practising using different types of sentences in our writing.*
- *Writing a report on growing plants*

*Support your child at home by talking to them about the core story*

*Reading with your child every day.*

*Practising reading and spelling the HFW.*

## Science



*This half term we will be: Plants*

- *Asking simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways.*
- *Using their observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions*
- *Observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.*
- *Finding out and describing how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.*

## Topic

- *Naming, locating and identifying characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas*
