

Reading

Listen to the story. Tell your parent/carer who is in the story? What did you like about the story? Can you find any sounds in the book that is in your name? What happens at the end of the story?

Who did the caterpillar meet? Can you draw the minibeasts in order? When you draw the characters think about which colours you need to use.

Use playdough to make your own caterpillar. What shape is the caterpillar's body?

What does the caterpillar say to the bee? What colour is the bee? Can you make the sound a bee makes? Create your own bee puppet.

Create your own caterpillar using coloured paper, toilet roll or paper plates. When you have made your caterpillar take a picture and send it to your class teacher.
