What we learnt so far in Year 6:	
History	This year we have been learning about <i>Ancient Greece</i> and its influence of life today.
Geography	In <i>Geography</i> we have been using our map skills to locate ideas and features we have encountered in our work such as compass directions, scaling in maps, mapping skill.
Science	In <i>Science</i> we have been learning about <i>Light</i> .
RE	In <i>R.E</i> children have been discussing the big question: why are certain places and people sacred?
