

Remember to think about what size each Billy Goat should be. Can you find 3 objects around your house to match the sizes - something big, something middle size and something small?</p>	<p>Design your own troll! You can draw a picture or use arts and craft materials to make a puppet of your troll. Think about the features you would like your troll to have.</p>	<p>Use empty boxes and other resources at home to make your own model of a bridge. Test your bridge to see how strong it is.
