Listen to the story. Tell your parent/carer who is in the story? Why was the ladybird unkind? Which things are you good at sharing?

Count how many different characters are in the story. Which is your favourite character? Why? Draw a picture of your favourite character.

Ladybird are easy to recognise because of the spots on their shells. Look carefully at the other characters. What special features do they have?

Who are your friends? Draw a picture of yourself sharing with your friends.

Retell the story in your own words. Make a video of you re-telling the story and send it to your class teacher.
