- Read a newspaper article. Write down 3 things you have learnt. Write 2 things you want to research and 1 thing you liked.



- Draw a picture of your favourite animal. Create a fact file about the animal. Use headings and subheadings to organise your work.
- Design your own board game. Write instructions to explain how to play it.
- Use 2 dice to make two 2 digit numbers. Multiply them together! Do 5 calculations and ask an adult to check your answers.
