

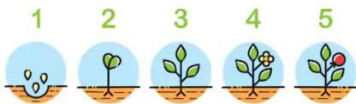


Year 6 Holiday Homework Activities

- How many times table questions can you answer in 30 seconds? Can you beat your record?
- Choose your favourite character and write a character profile. Show your family and friends, can they guess the character?
- Choose a book title. Act it out in front of your family. Can they guess the title?
- Design your own board game. Write instructions to explain how to play it.
- Use 3 dice to make two 3 digit numbers. Multiply them together! Do 5 calculations and ask an adult to check your answers.



- Plant some seeds and look after them. Draw what you observe each week and explain each stage of the lifecycle of a flower



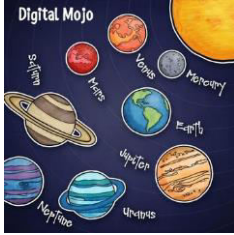
- Meditate for 5 minutes and think of 5 things which make you happy.
- Create a robot using empty boxes and bottles.



- Write a review about your favourite movie.
- Design your own video game. Imagine you will sell it, create a description for it.
- Listen to your favourite song and identify the instruments you can hear.



- Create an explanation text explaining the importance of a healthy lifestyle.
- Design yourself as a superhero and create a comic strip of the adventures you have been on.
- Create a model of a solar system.

- Write a letter to your teacher. What have you learn from them? What do you admire about them?
