



<p>50 things to do in school activity-</p> 	<p>Get your children to become Mini artists</p> <p>Painting and drawing allow children to focus on an open-ended task that is determined by themselves. The freedom to choose what, where, when, how and why. They will have fun, find ways to express themselves and learn about cause and effect.</p> <p>Making marks outside allows children to try BIG strokes and brush marks. Using water on a warm day means that your child can use a paint brush and bucket, a spray bottle filled with water or sponges and a bowl of water to make long lines or cover large areas.</p>
