Have a go at making your own witches hat. I wonder how you will decorate it.


There are some instructions below to help you.




Talk about what you can see. What job would you like when you are older?

In your pack find the picture of the room on the broom scene or see below.


Talk about what you can see in the picture.

Go outside in your garden. Use some water and a paintbrush or some chalk and paint/draw some 2D shapes.











Stretch: mmmmountain
