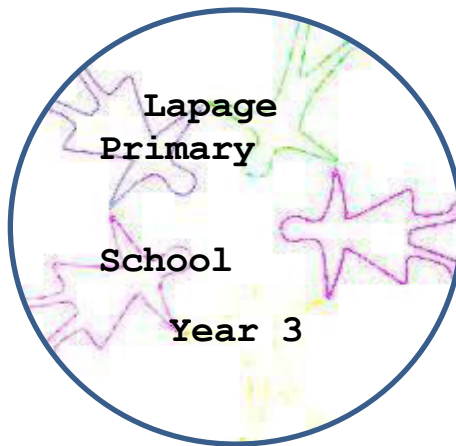

- Structure of a letter

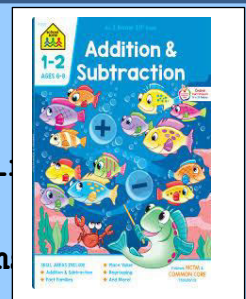


Support your child at home by talking about their writing when they write at home.

- Use multiplication skills to solve simple problems



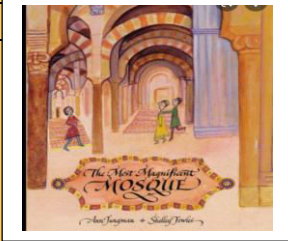
You could help your child at home by getting them to tell you the value of each digit in a number

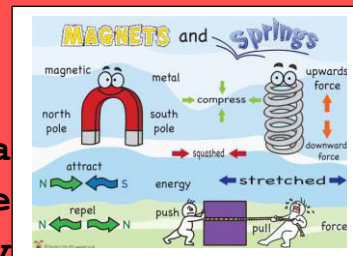
